- Educational advocacy: Support families who have children age birth to 26 years old who may need special education services
 to be successful in school.
- Social programs: Provide opportunities for ALL to be part of social programs in our community, including dances, sport opportunities, and summer recreation scholarships.
- Supportive services: Help people navigate the systems and resources available to those with developmental disabilities. This
 includes:
 - Support Groups: Opportunities for parents/caregivers and siblings to receive support.
 - o Representative Payee Services: Provide support to adults with disabilities to manage their social security benefits.
 - o Person Centered Planning: An expert led problem-solving process to help people with disabilities plan for their future.
 - o Resource Referral Help: Talk to an expert to find local resources on items like mental health, housing, financial planning and navigating governmental benefits.
 - Learning Opportunities: The Arc Livingston's experts and local partners share their knowledge on various disabilityrelated topics.
